THE U.S. IS FISCALLY RESTRICTED



The U.S. has the **second highest corporate tax rate** among the world's major industrial countries

Through inaction on free trade agreements **the U.S. is ceding market share** to many of its competitors



U.S. federal regulation costs \$1.7 trillion a year according to the Small Business Administration

70% of manufacturers pay income taxes at individual rates

The U.S. is a party to **only one of dozens of trade agreements** that are being negotiated around the world



Some 510,000 jobs would be created if the R&D jobs credit was strengthened and made permanent

It is 20% more expensive to do business in the U.S. than it is in those of its nine largest trading partners
